## Bogged Down?

So, you can't seem to grow anything in that low wet area of your yard except a mediocre stand of blue grass.

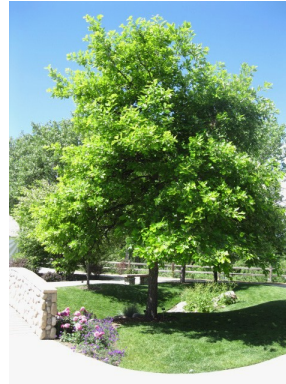
You've cut back your own sprinkler system, but your neighbor hasn't changed his four times a day sprinkler program in the six years since he moved in! That wet spongy spot in your yard is a man-made bog.

Don't despair. There are plants to select from that not only withstand wet conditions, but actually thrive in it. Please note that most plants need oxygen at their roots. So, if your area has standing water constantly, you might consider a secondary plan, such as hardy water plants or building up a berm so that water can drain away from root systems.

The following plant options are good choices for moist areas:

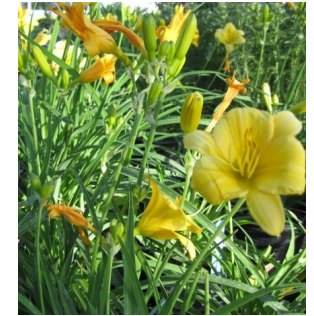
